MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Our Initiatives PBIS, PLCs, and Partnerships

We have been diligently working to create the most optimal educational environment for our Paradise school! We have narrowed our focus to put our energy into the right drivers. PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention Supports) is a research based system that builds capacity within our building and influences beyond. The goal of PBIS is to create a whole school system that focuses on explicit teaching of behavior and learning outcomes. Research shows an increase in attendance, academic achievement, teacher retention, and a positive school culture (<https://www.pbisrewards.com/blog/what-is-pbis/>). Our PBIS committee has facilitated a behavior matrix and has successfully administered climate surveys. The committee will analyze the data and address the results. In January, we will be starting our student store where students can purchase fun items in exchange for HAWK Bucks. The staff at CCCS will be giving away HAWK Bucks for students who are respectful, responsible, safe and prepared.

We are also focused on PLCs (Professional Learning Communities) where teachers focus on data driven results and best research based teaching instruction to move the academic needle in a positive direction. In PLC meetings, the CCCS staff is committed to addressing the whole child – social emotional needs, behavior needs, and academic needs.

Finally, we are committed to partnering with families. This year, we have implemented a monthly award assembly where students are recognized for attendance, PBIS traits (respect, responsibility, safety, and preparedness), HAWK of the Month, and Reading. We also hold a Parent Café meeting for families – a place for learning and partnering with the school. We have also been recognizing students through A Positive Phone Call Home from the Principal which has been extremely fun and full of happiness. It is our priority to have an open door relationship with all families and include families in all major decisions in order to provide the best experience possible.
